

Nature-relevant insights from 2022 (110 European Cities)

2003 - 2022

68%

of European cities are facing risks to public health or health systems associated with climate change (and 32% do not know or do not answer)

87%

of 155 Climate Risk and Vulnerability Assessments declared by European Cities consider factors other than 'Assessment considers nature' or 'Environment, Biodiversity and forestry'. Only 13%

48%

of European cities adaptation measures are "Ecosystembased actions" (incl. green infrastructure, ecological restoration, increase biological diversity, afforestation & reforestation, community-based natural resource management, adaptive land-use management)

Only 8%
of European cities declared mitigation actions aiming at increasing green space

5% only

and/or biodiversity

of Europe cities monitor biodiversity as an adaptation action
